Why sign up?

We are conducting a research study to see how specialized employment support programs for autistic adults may have better outcomes than more traditional programs. This meet and greet with employers is designed to facilitate neurodiverse job seekers in getting to know new people. Our hope is that this program will also help employers to get to know who you are and what you bring to a work environment.

Because we are studying the effects of the Neurodiversity at Work (NaW) on adults with autism and the Stanford Neurodiversity Job Fair/Reverse Job Fair is part of the NaW program, all those who participate in this Job Fair will also be participating in our research study. If you participate in the research, you will be asked to

- Complete various cognitive, behavioral, and diagnostic assessments through the duration of our study which will take place over 18 months.
- Allow us to collect data on you and your employment status over time
- Participate in our NaW program which will provide you with access to job openings and other resources

Participants will be involved in the study before and after onboarding. Duration of the job search phase is approximately 0 to 12 months. After onboarding, participants will be followed for approx. 18 months.
